6. Ensures Compliance with Regulations

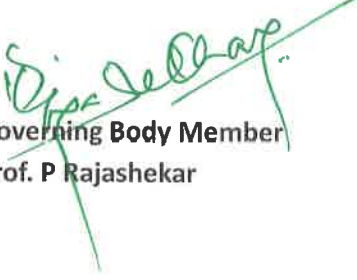
It ensures that admissions follow the rules and guidelines of affiliating bodies (like universities or regulatory authorities), avoiding legal or procedural issues.
